18 Accused awarded 7 years of RI each in case RC-04/2010/NIA/DLI
(SIMI Wagamon Camp Case)

On 15.05.2018, Hon'ble Special Court for NIA Cases, Ernakulam pronounced the quantum of punishment to the eighteen convicted accused persons in Case RC-04/2010/NIA/DLI (SIMI Wagamon Camp Case), viz. 1) Saduli P, native of Kerala, 2) Hafeez Hussain (A-native of Karnataka, 3) Safdar Nagori native of Madhya Pradesh, 4) P. A. Shibily native of Kerala, 5) Mohammed Ansar P.A. native of Kerala, 6) Abdul Sathar native of Kerala, 7) Aamil Parwaz native of Madhya Pradesh, 8) Mohammed Sami Bagevadi native of Karnataka, 9) Nadeem Sayeed native of Karnataka, 10) Mufti Abul Bashar native of Uttar Pradesh, 11) Dr. H.A. Asadulla native of Karnataka, 12) Kamaruddin Nagori native of Madhya Pradesh, 13) Shakeel Ahammed native of Karnataka, 14) Dr. Mirza Ahmed Baig native of Karnataka, 15) Danish native of Jharkhand, 16) Manzar Imam native of Jharkhand, 17) Mohammed Abu Faisal Khan native of Maharashtra and 18) Alam Jeb Afridi native of Gujarat. They have been awarded one year rigorous imprisonment and Rs. 25,000/- fine for the offence punishable under section 10 of UA(P) Act, five years of rigorous imprisonment for the offence punishable under section 38 of UA(P) Act, seven years of rigorous imprisonment and Rs. 25,000/- fine for the offence punishable under section 4 of Explosive Substances Act and seven years of rigorous imprisonment for the offences punishable under section 120B read with section 10 and 38 of UA(P) Act and section 4 of Explosive Substances Act.

2. The Court has also awarded sentence of seven years of rigorous imprisonment and fine of Rs. 50,000/- to the thirteen accused persons namely, 1) Saduli P, 2) Hafeez Hussain, 3) Safdar Nagori, 4) P. A. Shibily, 5) Mohammed Ansar P. A., 6) Abdul Sathar, 7) Aamil Parwaz, 8) Nadeem Sayeed, 9) Dr. H. A. Asadulla, 10) Kamaruddin Nagori, 11) Shakeel Ahammed, 12) Dr. Mirza Ahmed Baig, 13) Manzar Imam, convicted under section 20 of UA(P) Act.

3. All the sentences have been ordered to run concurrently.
