### **NIA Kochi takes up investigation of yet another ISIS case**

In compliance of MHA Order dated 31 May 2018, NIA has registered case RC-02/2018/NIA/KOC at the NIA Police Station, Kochi on 01.06.2018 under sections 38 and 39 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 against eight accused persons namely (1) Shaibu Nihar, native of Thamarassery, Kozhikode district, Kerala, (2) Manzoor, native of Kondotty, Malappuram district, Kerala, (3) Mansoor, native of Vadakara, Kozhikode district, Kerala (4) Shahnad, native of Kannur district, Kerala (5) Fajid, native of Quilandy, Kozhikode district, Kerala, (6) Ashraf Moulavi, native of Vaniyumbalam, Malappuram district, (7) Safeer, native of Perumbavur, Ernakulam district, Kerala, (8) Muhadis, native of Vaniyambalam, Malappuram district, Kerala and others and taken up the case of investigation.

The case was originally registered as Crime No. 263/ 2017 of Wandoor Police Station in Malappuram district of Kerala state under sections 38 and 39 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 on 06.11.2017 against the afore-mentioned eight accused persons and others for being members of the proscribed terrorist organization Islamic State of Iraq and Syria (ISIS)/ Daesh and for supporting the organization by travelling or preparing to travel from Bahrain to Syria for joining the proscribed terrorist organization that is waging war against the Asiatic nation having friendly relations with the Government of India.
