FICN OF FACE VALUE OF RS. 1.92 LAKH SEIZED BY NIA TEAM AT FARAKKA, MURSHIDABAD, WB

On 31st July, 2018 at 1800 hrs, NIA team seized Fake Indian Currency Notes (FICN) of face value of Rs. 1.92 lakh from the possession of one Abdul Rahim, near Hotel Pabitra, Farakka, District Murshidabad, West Bengal.

2. Acting on a credible information, NIA team had laid a trap in the periphery of the Hotel Pabitra, Farakka. At about 1800 hrs, the accused Abdul Rahim was intercepted by the NIA team at footpath near to the Hotel Pabitra. He was frisked by the officials of the NIA team and found in possession of the fake Indian currency notes having denomination of Rs. 2000/- in the right front pocket of his full pant. Accordingly FIR vide No. 297/2018 was registered at PS Farakka, against Abdul Rahim s/o Anarul Shaikh, age-32 yrs., r/o. Kashimnagar, Near Jodhopur Bus Stand, PS Kaliyachak, Malda, West Bengal and others U/Sec. 489B, 489C, 120B, 34 of IPC on 31/07/2018. It is suspected that the fake notes were printed and smuggled from across the border.
