NIA files chargesheet against 8 persons in the Arms & Ammunition theft case
in Manipur

In the “Theft of Arms and Ammunition from 2nd Manipur Rifles Battalion Kote” case, NIA submitted first chargesheet on 25.9.2018 against eight accused persons, namely, Laishram Anilkumar Singh (A-1), Thokchom James @ Tonao(A-2), Paonam Shantikumar Singh(A-3), Haobam Brojendro Singh (A-4), Ngamboi Haokip @ Raju(A-5), Nellikattil Podiyan Damodaran(A-6), Mathurabashimayum Hiranjoy Sharma @ Ngoubi (A-8), Laishram Damudor Singh @ Thembung (A-9) in the Court of Special Judge, NIA Manipur, Imphal u/s 120B, 381, 122 of IPC, s. 20, 23(1), 23(2), 18 of UA(P) Act and Section 25 (1AA) and 25 (1A) and 29 Arms Act.

2. During investigation, NIA has recovered/seized 20 numbers of 9mm Auto 1A Pistols and 05 numbers of Magazines. Seized firearms were missing from DG Pool Kote of Manipur, located at 2nd Manipur Rifles Battalion, Imphal.

3. Investigation continues under section 173(8) CrPC, against David Hangshing, Chairman of Kuki Revolutionary Army, Th Diamond Singh and Yamthong Haokip, MLA Saikul LAC, Manipur who are involved in the instant crime and also regarding involvement of other accused persons/militant groups in the instant case.
