



NIA has seized/attached movable/immovable property worth approximately Rs 7.23 Crores, belonging to members of Tritiya Prastuti Committee (TPC) in Jharkhand

In the past one week, NIA has seized moveable property and attached immovable property worth 7.23 Crores belonging to operatives of Tritiya Prastuti Committee (TPC) operating in Jharkhand. This has been done in connection with investigation of case RC-06/2018/NIA/DLI against members of TPC. NIA has already filed a charge sheet against TPC members in the court of NIA Spl Judge on 21/12/2018 against 16 members of TPC including 2 employees of Central Coalfields Limited (CCL) and some businessmen. The property attached belongs to TPC operatives Binod Kumar Ganjhu, Bindeshwar Ganjhu, Pradeep Ram and Akraman (Regional Commander of TPC).

2. Following properties have been attached so far :-

- i. 2 plots of land and double storeyed house belonging to TPC operative Binod Kumar Ganjhu, worth approximately Rs 90 lakhs.
- ii. 5 vehicles including 1 JCB loader, 1 Scorpio vehicle and 2 motor cycle worth of Rs 31 lakhs (approx.) of Binod Kumar Ganjhu.
- iii. 10 vehicles belonging to TPC operative Bindeshwar Ganjhu including 1 JCB loader vehicle and 10 trucks worth Rs 1.61 Crores.
- iv. 4 vehicles belonging to TPC operative Pradeep Ram including 1 JCB loader, 2 four wheeler and 1 two wheeler of estimated value Rs 41.25 Lacs.
- v. 3 acres of land having TATA motor service centre belonging to TPC Commander Akraman worth Rs 4 crores.

3. All the properties seized/ attached have been acquired by TPC members using terror funds collected by way of levy/ extortion.
